Pre-course orientation sessions:

- Two online sessions will be planned prior to the commencement of CMLC Online on 14 June. The dates and times for these sessions will be finalised in May, together with the students who have signed up and have been accepted for the course.

Course schedule:

- Monday 14 June – Friday 20 August.
- Classes will be held Monday – Friday each week, beginning at 8.15am – 12.00pm.
- Four classes (45 minutes) will be taught each day, with breaks included between each class.
- Every subject has written or practical assignments to complete.
- After five weeks of study, 19-23 July is planned as a 'rest' week.
- All classes will be taught live using the Zoom platform.

- All applications made until 31 March will benefit from a **€25 reduction**.






Questions & Answers

Q. What does the daily schedule look like?

A. Have a look at the schedule planned for week 1 of the CMLC. All times in this schedule are given in GMT (UK time). You need to calculate the time (GMT+1 or GMT+2) depending on where you live.

Q. Will the full 12-week course be taught this summer?

A. No – only the first 6 weeks of the course will be taught online, spread over 9 weeks of teaching.

Q. Do I need to attend all the classes?

A. Yes, if you are enrolled in the CMLC then you are expected to attend all the classes. Of course, there can be legitimate reasons why you may need to miss some classes (ill health, doctor appointment, etc.) In these situations, you need to inform the CMLC online administrator so that the classes can be recorded for you to watch later.

Q. What kind of assignments are given at CMLC?

A. There are a variety of assignments given – written/essay; practical (e.g., teaching a Bible lesson as you would for children); written tests; group work assignments; Scripture memorization, etc. As a rule, approximately two hours of assignments are given each day to complete.

Q. Besides attending classes and setting time aside for assignments, what other activities do I need to be aware of?

A. Other activities, like the fellowship and prayer time, and chat groups, will be discussed and decided together.

Essentials – to make the most of studying at CMLC Online:

- ◆ Have a good and stable internet connection.
- ◆ Use a device (laptop, iPad, etc.,) with at least a 15-inch screen size (or bigger). Smart phones or iPhones are not recommended.
- ◆ Ensure you can join the Zoom classroom with your camera switched on.
- ◆ Have a mic that functions so you can participate in class discussions, breakout groups & other activities.
- ◆ Have a Gmail account as Google classroom will be our digital campus where files, notes and resources will be stored and made available for download. Assignments and other course information will also be posted in the CMLC Google classroom.
- ◆ Have a designated study area – free from noise and distractions.
